Premises Development – March 2023

Despite there being no outdoor bowling over the winter, there has been plenty of activity up at the Club!

Following the successful improvements to the Club performed in early 2022 (car park hard standing, expansion of club ground boundary and creation of a new entrance at the side of the clubhouse), at the Club AGM last November 2022, the members agreed to invest in further enhancements, namely:

- Improvements to the ladies washroom
- Creation of a proper bar, replacing the outdoor fridge and table!
- Expansion of the outside covered area through installation of a more permanent structure.
